

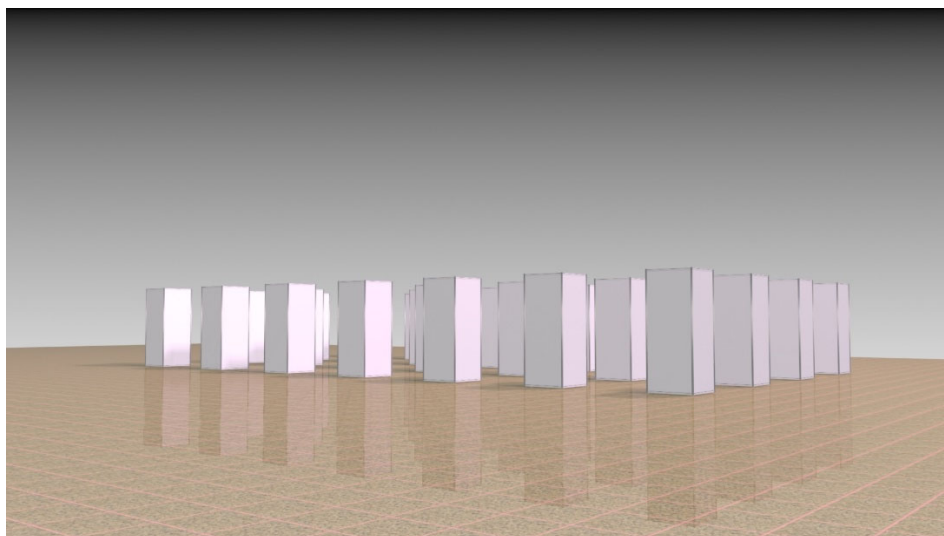
Congratulations on your acceptance for attendance and presentation at the Cell Culture Engineering XVIII meeting. As the poster sessions have been an important means of interacting with colleagues and sharing technical data, the poster committee is grateful for your submission. The maximum poster size is 1 meter in width and 1.5 m in height (portrait format). Poster information including the assigned poster number will be initially published on the conference website and will also be available on the conference App.

Poster program details:

Poster presenters are requested to set up their posters from 12:30-17:30 on Sunday, April 23, or at the presenter's earliest convenience after this set-up time. The poster session will occur in the Grand Coral Ballroom 1 and Foyer, both on the fourth floor. The first poster session will start on the first night of the conference, Sunday, April 23, and poster sessions will be held in the evenings on the first four nights of the conference. Presenters are requested to stand by their posters on alternate days (even-numbered posters on Sunday and Tuesday evening and odd-numbered posters on Monday and Wednesday). Posters have been grouped by the primary category indicated by the presenter when the abstract was submitted. The poster committee requests that posters remain on display throughout the conference days on which there are poster sessions, and posters MUST be taken down after the poster session on the evening of Wednesday, April 26. Posters that remain after the conference has been concluded will be discarded.

Set-up details:

The maximum poster size is 1 meter in width and 1.5 m in height (portrait format). Posters will be presented on "hard boards," see below for picture of the poster presentation surface. Poster boards and double sided tape will be provided as the preferred method of hanging posters. For posters made of heavier materials, clips for hanging will also be available but note that hard boards are nearly 2.5 m high so hanging is a more complicated option. Posters should be set up at the appropriate hard board designated by poster number that is found on the conference website and will be on the conference App as the conference draws near. Participants will be notified that photography will not be allowed in conference communications, the conference App and by signage at the poster session locations.



Poster Competition:

Poster competition for those who registered as graduate students and post-docs. Further details on the poster competition will be provided at the conference.
